WIDOW EMPOWERMENT & WELLNESS OUTREACH;

APRIL 19, 2025

In collaboration with Help for All International, HHF hosted a special outreach program themed “Empowering Widows to Thrive Beyond Just Surviving.”

Over 50 widows benefitted from free medical screening, relief materials, and emotional support in an atmosphere filled with joy, songs, and renewed hope.

- Free medical check-ups and health talks
- Distribution of relief materials and food packages

- 50 widows reached
- Access to healthcare and counseling
- Restored hope, emotional support, and renewed confidence



CAMPAIGN AGAINST TEENAGE VIOLENCE;

MAY TO JULY 2025



HHF organized a 3-hour intensive workshop equipping school counselors with practical tools to identify, prevent, and manage aggression and bullying among teenagers.

The program received strong institutional support from:

- Lagos State Neighborhood Safety Corps
- Ministry of Education, Guidance & Counseling Unit

Training Content

- Root causes of teenage aggression
- Emotional intelligence
- Peer mediation & conflict resolution
- Student engagement
- Building safe & inclusive learning environments

Key Achievements

- Trained 50 school counselors from over 25 schools
- Secured commitments for Phase 2:
- PEACE COHORTS
- Established Peace Clubs in two schools:
- Luwasa Senior High School
- Abule-Eko Community Senior Grammar School
- 40 new Peace Ambassadors (20 per school)

These students now serve as peer mediators promoting nonviolence, unity, and peaceful conflict resolution.



COMMUNITY OUTREACH WITH HAVEN FOR LOVE & GRACE FOUNDATION;

JULY 14, 2025

Together with Haven for Love & Grace Foundation, HHF co-hosted a self-awareness and wellness outreach themed “A Call to Self-Awareness” for 100 teenage girls.

MTN SPELLING BEE
GRAND FINALE

29th November 2025

HHF mobilized 31 students from Odogunyan, Ikorodu, to attend the MTN Spelling Bee Grand Finale at The Grand Plaza. For many of these children, it was their first exposure to a national academic platform previously perceived as “for elite schools.”

Students described the experience as unforgettable, and the event broadened their confidence, aspirations, and belief in their own potential.
